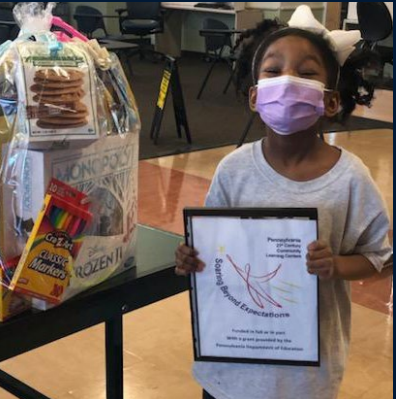

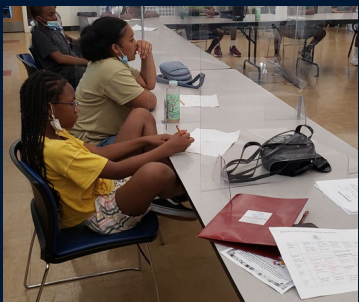
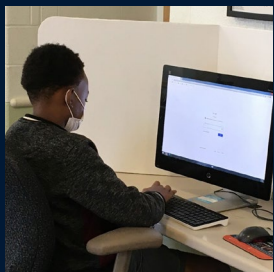


BGCC Programs

The Boys & Girls Club of Chester (BGCC) Student Achieve afterschool program was created through a partnership among the Pennsylvania Department of Education 21st Century Learning Communities, Chester Upland School District (CUSD), and the BGCC. Through this partnership BGCC has been designated to operate one of the CUSD Student Achieve afterschool programs. Children participating in the BGCC 21st Century Community Learning Center (21st CCLC) receive homework help to support their academic development and are engaged in afterschool programming focused on Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math (STEAM). Our program is designed to help students meet state and local student standards; offer students a broad array of enrichment activities that complement the work they receive in school; and offer other educational services to the families of participating children.

Summer Camp

The BGCC Summer Camp is designed to provide a hands-on, minds-on, project-based programming for youth in 1st through 8th grade.

Modeled after the Boys & Girls Club of America's Summer Brain

Game program, the BGCC combines academic enrichment with hands on projects and activities that offer both mental and physical stimulation. Our six- week summer enrichment camp engages members in a host of STEAM enrichment activities that focus on math, reading, art and science. All of the academic enrichment is integrated with fun activities such as gardening, cooking, science experiments; basketball math hoops games; and robotics, digital literacy and computer games to engage students in technology. The summer arts program is comprised of puppet theatre, music, and photography. Through Positive Action, our evidence-based program and our Girls Rock and Kings Talk groups, children participate in interactive social emotional activities and workshops. The BGCC 21 st CCLC Summer Camp program is a full day program.

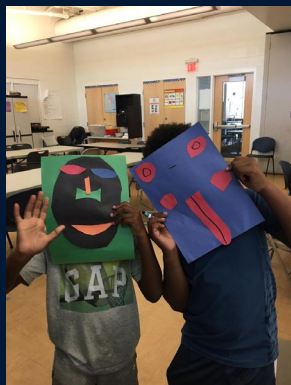
BGCC Programs



Arts & Crafts

The art program provides children with a hands on experience to express their creativity and promote critical thinking. This workshop gives children the opportunity to create art projects such as painting and self-portraits and design and complete more intricate projects that require 2-3 sessions to complete such as making robotics out of cardboard and making their hand print out of clay. The majority of the art projects requires the children to reflect on themselves, and creatively recreate their face, hands and body.

Class is provided 2 days per week.

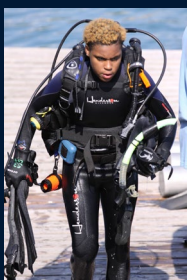

Scuba Diving

In collaboration with the Atlantic Rangers SCUBA Youth Education Service (ATRA-Y.E.S.) Club, the Boys & Girls Club of Chester (BGCC) offers a 6-month diver certification course for six youth age 13 – 18. Since 1991, ATRA-Y.E.S. has been instrumental in certifying young divers in the Delaware County area. Instructors serve as career mentors for youth by providing a supportive environment that engenders teamwork, confidence and trust. Youth between the ages 13-14 will earn a Junior Open Water Diver or Junior Scuba Diver certification (adult supervised diving) and those 15-18 years old can earn an Open Water Diver or Scuba Diver certification whereas no adult supervision is required. Classroom instruction is conducted by trained PADI certified instructors using the PADI curriculum. PADI is the Professional Association of Diving Instructors. PADI is the world's largest diver training organization. The pool instruction is a three step process consisting of Confined water dives, knowledge development, and open water dives to prepare the youth for Scuba diving.

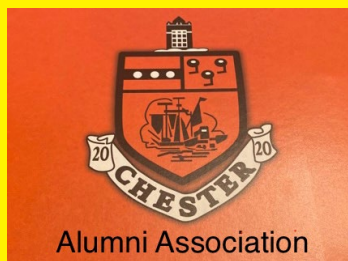
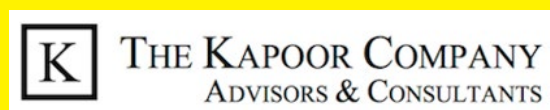

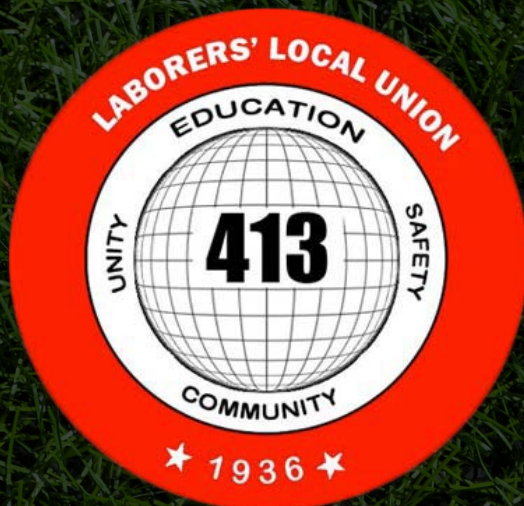
